Dear Scoutmaster,

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is an intense six day training course for Scouts. This course provide Scouts with the leadership skills they need to be truly effective. It is the most advanced youth leader training that Scouting offers. NYLT features instruction in modern corporate leadership skills that can be used at home, school, on the job and of course the Scout's own Troop! A trained staff of youth leaders and instructors work closely with qualified adult mentors to conduct this course. Participants and their training "patrols" get an opportunity to practice and experience state of the art leadership skills for highly effective teams— firsthand!

Scoutmasters select and nominate the Scouts who may attend NYLT, sending those who currently or will soon hold key leadership positions in the Troop. Scouts attending must be at least 13 years old by the first day of the course and have obtained the rank of First Class (no exceptions) Nominees should have completed the Troop's own Troop Leadership Training experience and have had at least one leadership position within the Troop. A Troop may send up to five Scouts to NYLT; if you have more that you would like to attend, contact the Council Service Center to have those additional Scouts put on a waiting list.

A minimum of \$50 must be sent in with the Scout's application as a deposit. If application and deposit are received by April 1st the early bird fee is \$150. After that the regular fee of \$200 takes effect. All applications and deposits are due no later than May 10th and any outstanding balances must be paid at check-in.

The fee includes all meals, equipment use, training materials, T-shirt, cap, patch and certificate. If the Scout wishes, additional T-shirts may be pre-ordered for \$10 (see brochure for complete details).

The course will begin with check-in at 12:00 Noon on Sunday, June 14th at Camp Horace Johnson. All Scouts should be checked in no later than 12:30 p.m. The course will conclude with a closing ceremony at approximately 1:00 p.m. Saturday June 19th in which all parents/guardians are invited to attend. The Participant must be able to attend the entire course.

Enclosed you will find a brochure with an application. Please share this information with the boys that you would like to attend and make sure to send it in to the address indicated. It is highly recommended that you do not wait as this course is limited to the first 35 who register and we are expecting a full course this year.
