REGISTERING A SUPER TIGER?

We welcome our newest cub scouts to attend camp. A Tiger would be a boy who will be entering the 1st Grade in Fall 2017. It is required that an adult parent is with the Tiger at all times.

LUNCH/FOOD

Please make sure to pack a **LUNCH AND SNACK** for your son each day.

We are a NUT FREE camp!

We want to make camp safe for ALL attendees. We will be dedicating sufficient lunch space for a peanut/nut free table(s). If your child has allergies, *please* make sure to include them on the required **HEALTH HISTORY** form, and discuss any concerns/treatments with the medical officer or camp director on day one.

IMPORTANT!!

HEALTH HISTORY FORMS

All participants are required to complete a **HEALTH HISTORY** Form A and B. No physical exam or physician signature is required.

FORMS must be turned in at drop off on the 1st day of camp or emailed to Chris before camp starts. They will be returned to you on the last day.

Our goal is to keep your Scout safe.

WATER

Please make sure to send a water bottle with your scout *every day*. He will be able to fill and re-fill it throughout the day. We want to make sure they are drinking plenty of water as it may be hot and the scouts will be active.

ADVENTURES/ ELECTIVES

At the end of camp, we will be providing you/your Super Hero with a list of achievements that they have completed while at camp.

Depending on your Pack/Den, you can either give this to your Den leader or enter it into your tracking system. The important part is that the scout will be very proud of what he has completed so please share with him what his hard work has achieved.

NEED HELP? GOTTA QUESTION?

If during camp, you need to speak with someone about a concern or have a question, please look for an adult in an **ORANGE CAMP T-SHIRT** or a BSA uniformed adult. **PLEASE** make sure you convey any important information directly – such as early pick up, new person authorized to pick up, etc. We want the Scouts to have fun, but they aren't the best messengers.

- PLEASE NOTE -

The camp activities will primarily be **OUTDOORS**.

- Please make sure your scout dresses for the weather.

-- Please make sure your scout is wearing solid, close toed footwear – no flips flops, no open toes.

On the first day, your scout will be given a camp T-shirt. This is their uniform shirt for camp.

Lunches/Snacks will be gathered at the beginning of each day and stored in a cooler. However, please make sure that your lunch choices do not “require” refrigeration to keep from spoiling. We don't want any scouts to become ill.



It is advised that you **APPLY BUG SPRAY & SUN BLOCK** to your scout each morning. Send bug spray & sun block with your Scout in their backpack. We will only assist scouts in reapplying their own products. This is to avoid allergic reactions.

- DIRECTIONS TO CAMP NEWMAN -

From the West-

Follow WI HWY 35 south out of Superior toward Pattison Park, Turn left on County Hwy B and follow it to County Hwy A (3 miles to the stop sign). Turn right on County Hwy A and follow it 3.5 to the Tri Lakes Road and take a left (between two taverns). Follow the East Tri Lakes Road 1.9 around the lakes. Follow the road until it turns into gravel going left as the pavement goes to the right. Keep left and go about 8 tenths of a mile to the Camp Newman gate that is on the left.

From the East

Follow WI Hwy 53 to Douglas County Road B go west on County B 7.4 miles to the South Najt Road. Turn Left and follow the road 1.9 miles to the fork. Keep to the right at the fork go to the stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign (onto the East Tri Lakes Road) follow the road 1.9 miles to entrance and gate for Camp Newman (On your right).

DROP OFF/ PICK UP/PARKING

We will have 50+ scouts being dropped off & picked up every day. The logistics of arrival & departure are tricky (think school pickup). We will be marking our list as your scout arrives & departs.

Please park on the tri lakes road and walk in.

VOLUNTEERS

Please be aware that this camp is staffed with volunteers.

They have volunteered to create a fun program experience for your scout. What this means is that sometimes the best plans may not account for all scenarios. Mistakes may be made. Our goal is to have a safe environment in which the scouts can have fun. If you have concerns, please let Chris or Hollie or an adult wearing a **ORANGE** camp shirt/BSA uniform know. We will work to address anything that arises.

BE A HERO! If you are interested in volunteering, Day Camp is a great way to spend some time with your son. We are always looking for volunteers to run activities, walk with scout groups, etc. **PACKS sending Scouts need to send an adult for every 5 Scouts registered.** If you are interested in volunteering – please contact Chris or Hollie.
